## Recipe For a Route Description

1. Type of path (Footpath, Bridleway, Byway, National Trail, Orange road, Yellow road)
2. Direction ( $\mathrm{N}, \mathrm{S}, \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{W}, \mathrm{SE}, \mathrm{NW}$ etc.)
3. Distance $(300 \mathrm{~m}, 0.5 \mathrm{~km}, 1.2 \mathrm{~km}$ etc.)
4. Distinguishing features (Through woods, past Rectory Farm, uphill, downhill, across path junction, handrailing river on left etc)

## 5. To a Point where either you change direction or the path type changes

For example:
a. Footpath SW for 400 m past mast to cross paths, then brideway W for 1.5 km downhill to junction with orange road.
b. Byway N 1 km past J oe's farm to junction with road, 200 m west on road then bridleway N to Green Woods.
c. Footpath N, curving NE 1.5km to Manor house, then Bridleway E 500 m past church to junction with footpath.

4. Distinguishing features (Through woods, past Rectory Farm, uphill, downhill, across path junction, handrailing river on left etc)

## 5. To a Point where either you change direction or the path type changes
